Wentworth prides itself on enrolling a highly diverse student population. The Class of 2026 hails from **24** states and **31** countries. A third of the incoming class is first generation, **26%** are students of color and **21%** are Pell-eligible.

Wentworth offers nationally accredited bachelors and masters degrees in engineering, computing, management and design through a cooperative learning model. Accelerated BS/MS programs are available to students with AP/IB credit. An NCAA Division III institution, Wentworth fields 16 varsity teams.

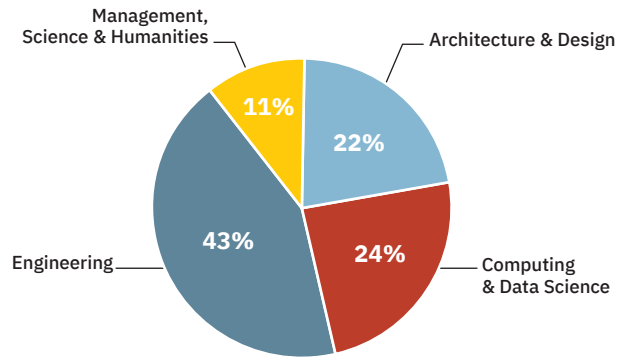
** Note: Wentworth adopted a test-optional admissions policy in 2019. Candidates do not need to submit standardized test scores to receive full consideration for merit scholarships.*
