MOVE-IN & CHECK-IN

What to expect

Check-in will take place in West Lot (see map) on Sunday, July 10, during the designated move-in time block. Once students make their way into West Lot, we will instruct families to park their vehicle and proceed to check-in. Upon checking in, each participant will receive a detailed schedule of events, their room assignment, and a lanyard with an ID Card to be worn throughout the program. Once you collect your materials you will receive a blue bin, where you can add your belongings and staff will help direct you from West Lot to 610 Huntington Ave. Please see the Orientation schedule for more information. If you are traveling from a long distance and do not plan to make the morning check-in, please let us know of your travel plans ASAP and we will make necessary arrangements for your early arrival.

*Parents and families of participants attending both sessions of ImpactLab need to attend only the Session I Orientation & Move-In day.

Pre-arrival COVID-19 Testing

All participants attending the program must conduct a pre-arrival test and submit their results. All participants must produce proof of a negative COVID test (PCR or Rapid Antigen Test) administered by a testing center. Provide test results 24-48 hours prior to arrival via email at precollege@wit.edu. Results must include students name and date of the test. Please note at home testing will not be accepted.

We will have nursing staff on site during Move-In that will be able to provide a COVID-19 rapid test in the event of an emergency or necessary re-test. Please note that all students are still required to submit pre-arrival testing.

In all indoor spaces, face masks are optional for students who are fully vaccinated and boosted. Face masks are highly recommended for students who have vaccine expemtions. We ask that participants respect and support those who wish to continue masking during the program.

What to pack

Below is a recommended packing list for participants. Please note that this is not comprehensive and these are just recommendations, not requirements.


- Activities for down time (cards, games, books, gaming system, etc.)
- Clothing items: shirts, shorts, pants (some labs will require you to wear pants for safety)
- Sweatshirt (AC in buildings can be chilly)
- Closed-toe-shoes (sneakers for labs and activities)
- Additional blanket if needed
- Snacks and drinks (no nut products please!)
- Personal hygiene products
- Shampoo, conditioner, body wash, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Deodorant
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen and bug repellent
- Medications (if applicable)

*Pre-college Programs staff will be providing one set of bed linens and towels for each session.
