CO-OP

Active for more than 40 years, Wentworth's co-op program is one of the largest and most comprehensive of its kind in the nation.

- Every student at Wentworth must complete two semesters of full-time, full-semester work experiences that are directly related to their majors.
- Students have dedicated advisors in the Center for Cooperative Education and Career Development who guide students through their co-op searches and career planning.
- The department hosts many recruiting events for our students to meet with employers wishing to hire them.
- Co-ops can be completed anywhere geographically since students are not taking classes during their co-op semesters.
- Neurodivergent students may wish to take advantage of ASPIRE@Wentworth, a collaborative program with Massachusetts General Hospital, for an extra layer of on-the-co-op-job support.

Wentworth is test-optional. All admitted students are automatically considered for merit scholarships.

FINANCIAL AID
