

Colleges of the Fenway Consortium (COF)

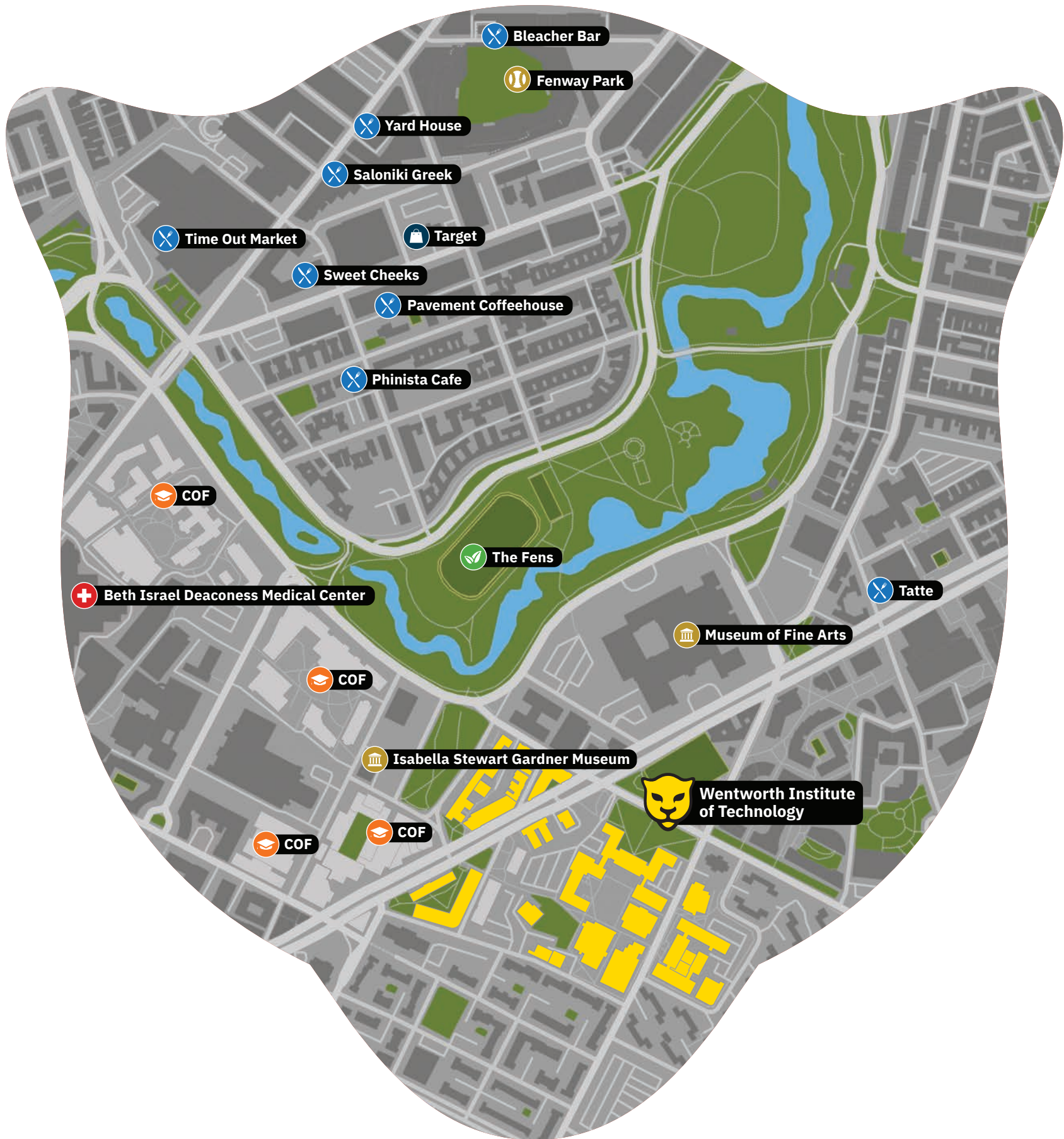

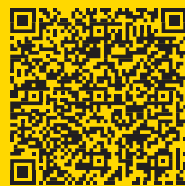
